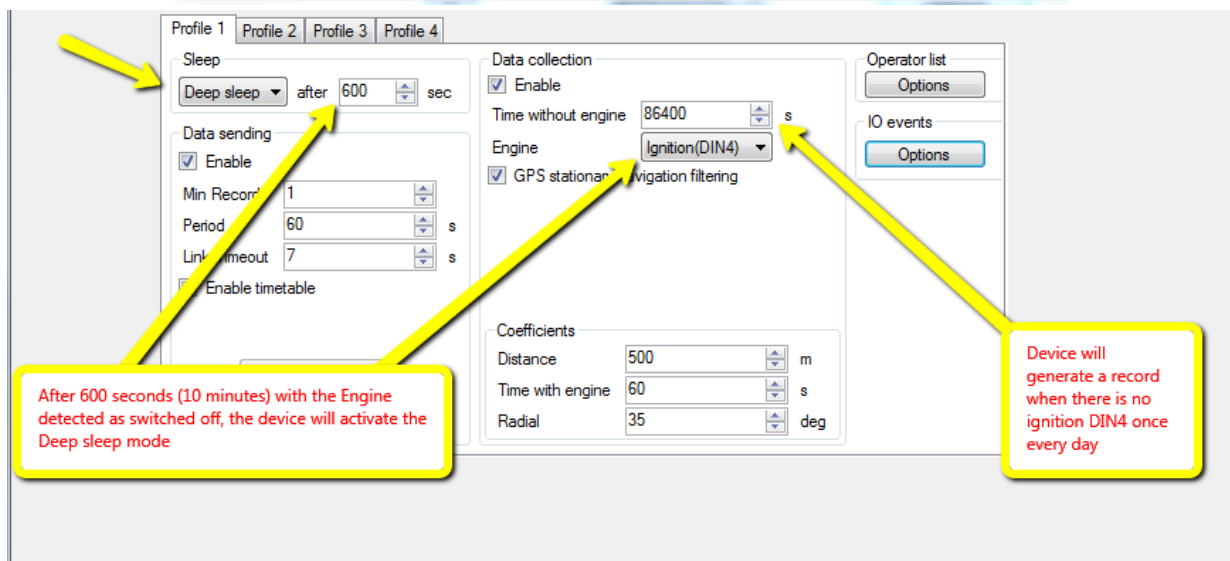
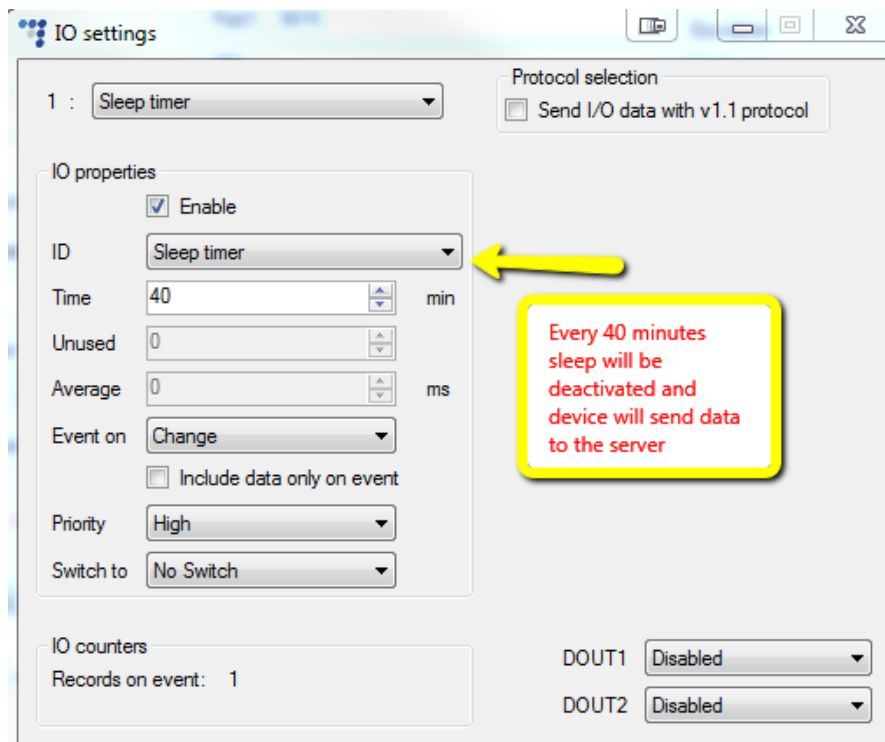

Configuration

Protocol 1.1 is not required. With protocol 1.0 you can use this functionality and edit its parameters.



Once the device starts Sleep mode, it will start counting the time for the Sleep timer parameter, and when it will reach it, it will deactivate the Sleep mode and switch on the GPS and GSM modems to send data to the server.

If the device wakes up before the time is reached, and afterwards returned back to sleep mode, the counting of the parameter will start over from 0.

The parameter ID is 174. Sleep timer, 1 Byte, with values of 0 (inactive) or 1 (active because the configured time was reached).
